NO CLUB MEMBERSHIP CARD — NO SHOOTING!

CLUB MEMBERS ONLY — NO GUESTS NOT EVEN TO WATCH!

YOU MAY NOT SHOOT ON A MEMBERSHIP RECEIPT!

- 1) The archery range will be open only to Elstonville Club members only.
- 2) Remember at all times that a bow and arrow is a deadly weapon that is as dangerous as a gun in the hands of an irresponsible person.
- There will be no consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs on the archery range at any time. No person shall be permitted in the archery range area while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 4) Remember that safety is the foremost consideration by all users.
- 5) You must be at least **18 years** old to shoot at the range alone.
- 6) Arrows will be released only in the direction of downrange targets using the provided backstops.
- 7) All bows pulled to full-draw must be aimed downrange toward appropriate target.
- 8) All archers must keep fingers away from quick release until the arrow is aimed downrange at an appropriate target and the archer is ready to release.
- 9) Multiple archers (two or more) may not release arrows at a single target at the same time.
- 10) An arrow may not be nocked or bow pulled to full-draw while another archer is downrange removing an arrow or arrows from a target.
- 11) Make sure that all persons around you are aware of your whereabouts when you are searching for arrows.
- 12) Never release an arrow when you cannot see where it will land. Never shoot an arrow straight up. Make sure the target is clear before you shoot. KNOW YOUR TARGET AND BEYOND!
- 13) No broadheads at any time in any butt targets Field points only.
- 14) Never shoot a broken arrow, please inspect each arrow carefully as it is retrieved.
- 15) Bow hunters needing to practice with broadheads are required to provide their own cube or broadhead targets.
- 16) All trash or litter will be removed from the archery range when the archer departs the range.
