



## HOUSE RULES

- Loud and excessive noise or profane language will not be tolerated.
- Business meetings are not permitted at the bar.
- Club membership cards must be shown to receive your first drink.
- New Members may enter the Association on a receipt until their Membership is issued. They must be signed in by an active Member and are not permitted to make purchases of any kind until receiving a Membership Card.
- If a Member sponsors a Guest, the Member must stay with that Guest. When the Member vacates the premises, the Guest must also leave. The Guest is permitted to be signed in only one (1) time per day. The Guest may not come back into the establishment with another sponsor on that same day.
- Members who fail to renew their annual dues within the time allowed must complete a new membership application and rejoin as a new Member for the cost of (\$50.00) dollars, losing prior active status as a Member.
- No person under the age of twenty-one (21) is permitted to participate in Small Games of Chance.
- No person under the age of twenty-one (21) is permitted to be seated at the bar at any time.
- **All persons under the age of twenty-one (21) must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times while in the bar area.**
- Children under the age of twelve (12) are not permitted to shoot darts or play pool.

- All persons under the age of eighteen (18) must vacate the premises by 10:00 PM. When a club function is scheduled, premises must be vacated by 9:00 PM. This includes ages eighteen (18) through twenty (20). You must be twenty-one (21) years of age to stay for a club function. (Times may vary, if so it will be posted)
- Children must be twelve (12) years of age or older and have completed a Hunter's Safety Course to participate in Block Shoots. They must also be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times.
- Only Members are permitted to utilize the Rifle Range. "NO GUESTS" You must have your Membership Card displayed while on the range.
- The Rifle Range age limit is six (6) years of age. They must be accompanied by an immediate family member that is a Member. Children ages twelve (12) and older, and is a Junior Member, may utilize the Range if accompanied by a legal parent or guardian.
- All beverage pitchers must be served at tables; pitchers are not permitted at the bar.
- Bartenders are not permitted to loan money to any person while on duty.
- Bartenders are not permitted to play Small Games of Chance games if they sold tickets out of a game. If they did not sell tickets out of a game they are permitted to purchase tickets out of that game.
- Bartenders are the only persons permitted to open the main entrance door when the bell rings. If a Member does not have a membership card in their possession they must sign the register book. If this practice is repeated three (3) times, that person will not be permitted inside the club until the membership card is visible to the bartender.
- Over pouring of alcohol is prohibited.
- Serving alcohol to visibly intoxicated persons is not permitted.
- Bartenders are not permitted to drink any alcoholic beverages before their shift
- PLCB rules state one (1) FREE drink per patron per day is permitted
- Small Games of Chance tickets are not permitted to be held. Tickets must be cashed in. No tickets can be removed from the club.

- Winning tickets of over \$100.00 must have a signed receipt from the winner. If a guest holds a winning ticket, the Club sponsor must also sign the receipt of a winning ticket of over \$100.
- No Member is permitted to buy out a Small Games of Chance ticket bowl
- All Small Games of Chance bowls are open bowls. All patrons shall have common courtesy to every person playing these games. All patrons are permitted to play any game at any time during regular business hours.
- No free jar bowl tickets will be given away. (exception; if there is a faulty bowl. Ex – If there are three (3) tickets to a bundle and only two (2) were included in the bundle).
- Illegal Controlled Substances are not permitted on Club Premises. This type of behavior is not tolerated. Any person caught doing illegal behavior will result in the loss of a Club Privileges.
